Eastpointe Resurfacing Project Underway

The resurfacing project on Eastpointe Drive, between SR 93 and the entrance to Dollar General Warehouse, began September 28. It will take ~45 days to complete. The Port Authority was able to leverage over \$275,000 in grant dollars toward this project, with grant funding coming from JobsOhio and ODOT.









Muskingum County Transportation District Receives Auditor of State Award

Auditor of State Keith Faber announced that the Muskingum County Transportation Improvement District received the Auditor of State Award for the 2018 - 2019 clean audit reports. The Auditor's office presents the Auditor of State Award to local governments and school districts upon the completion of a financial audit.

Entities that receive the award meet the following criteria of a "clean" audit report:

- The entity must file financial reports with the Auditor of State's office by the statutory due date, without extension in accordance with Generally Accepted Accounting Principles;
- The audit report does not contain any findings for recovery, material citations,

material weakness, significant deficiencies, Uniform Guidance findings or questioned costs:

- The entity's management letter contains no comment related to:
 - Ethics referrals
 - Questioned costs less than the threshold per the Uniform Guidance
 - · Lack of timely annual financial report submission
 - Bank reconciliation issues
 - Failure to obtain a timely Single Audit in accordance with Uniform Guidance
 - Findings for recovery less than \$500
 - Public meetings or public records issues
- The entity has no other financial or other concerns.

The MCTID received this award for the 2016 - 2017 audit as well.



TechCred Application Period Opens

The most recent TechCred application period closed at the end of August.During this round, **288 Ohio employers** were approved for funding, resulting in Ohio employees earning up to **4,468 technology-focused credentials**. The August round was recordsetting, approving **1,227** more credentials than were approved in June 2020, which previously held the award record.

Since the program's start, a total of **983 Ohio employers** have been approved for funding, supporting the earning of **11,941 tech-focused credentials** by Ohio employees. This round marks a milestone as funding has been approved for over 10,000 credentials.

The sixth TechCred application periodopened on **Thursday, October 1** st and closes on **October 30** th .

The former Muskingum County Board of Developmental Disabilities building, located at 655 Zane Street, will go up for Public Auction on Thursday, November 19, 2020 at 10:00 a.m. The Muskingum County Commissioners have authorized the sale of the property with a reserve bid of \$700,000, and reserve the right to reject any and all bids.
